- Falsework
- Staircases (tube & fit system)
- Ramps
- Cantilever drop scaffold
- Risk Assessments
- Method Statements
- Testing of ties and TG4
- NVQ** level 3 registration and information
- 50 Question Test Paper (includes intermediate test at the end of the 1st week)
