Course Specification

Duration: 2 days

Attendees: Existing CISRS card holders who have attended a minimum of a Trainee Scaffolder Part 1 Training Course and who use or plan to use Cuplok system scaffolding.

Objectives: To provide attendees with training in Cuplok system scaffolding to enable them to safely erect, alter and dismantle, under supervision of a CISRS Scaffolder or Advanced Scaffolder (if attendee is a Trainee Scaffolder) Cuplok system scaffolding. This course includes a pass/fail test and assessment exercise.

Content:

- Introduction (incl: Health & Safety Regulations, British & European Standards)
- Industry Standards, Component range and erection methods
- Bracing, Ties, and Stability
- Loading and Duties
- Access Towers – Theory and practical
- Independent Tied Scaffolds (incl: returns and hop-ups) – Theory and practical
- Birdcage Access Scaffolds – Theory and practical
- Methods of access and egress (incl: staircases) – Theory and practical
- Bridging with beams – Theory only
- Loading Towers – Theory and practical
- Assessment exercises
- Test paper

Certification: CISRS certificate of training
