Duration: 10 days

Attendees: Trainee Scaffolders who have a minimum of 6 months experience within the scaffolding industry.

Objectives: To give the attendees both theoretical and practical knowledge to enable them to work as a member of a team, under the direct supervision of a qualified CISRS Scaffolder at all times, to erect, alter and dismantle the scaffold structures below safely and in their correct sequence.

Content:

- Health and Safety Awareness course (1 day)
- Instruction/Training SG4 (½ day)
- Introduction to CISRS* and NVQ** schemes
- Product familiarisation in approved prefabricated systems scaffold
- Interpretation of simple drawings
- Safe handling and inspection of materials
- Tie methods and TG4
- Ropes and knots
- Types and uses of tube, fittings and boards
- Assessing material requirements for basic scaffolds
- Safe ladder access/egress
- Independent tied scaffold (in tube and fittings and in approved system)
- Putlog and Birdcage scaffolds
- Static Tower (in tube and fittings and in approved system)
- Alterations to scaffolds (eg: dropping lift height on independent)
- 50 Question Test Paper (includes intermediate test at end of 1st week)
