

CISRS* Advanced Scaffold Inspection Course Specification

Duration: 2 days

Attendees: Management/Supervision who have had a minimum of 12 months experience since attending a CISRS Basic Scaffold Inspection course who now need to inspect Advanced Tube & Fittings scaffolding and completion of a report in accordance with the Work at Height Regulations 2005.

Objectives: To develop in attendees an understanding of scaffold components, forms of construction and inspection procedures of advanced tube and fitting access scaffolds in accordance with statutory regulations and codes of practice.

Content:

- Regulations, Codes of Practice and Industry Guidance (NASC)
- Requirements common to all scaffolds – recap from Basic course
- Interpreting scaffold drawings and specifications
- Two way, Raking and Dead shores
- Slung and suspended scaffolding
- Staircase scaffolding
- Temporary roofs
- Truss out scaffolding
- Temporary ramps
- Cantilever drop scaffold
- Splay scaffolds
- Multi choice examination
- Practical scaffold inspection examination

Certification: CISRS Certificate of training upon completion of course and successful completion of both examinations.
