Objectives: To give the attendees both theoretical and practical knowledge to enable them to work as a member of a team, under the direct supervision of a qualified CISRS Scaffolder at all times, to erect, alter and dismantle the scaffold structures on the Trainee Scaffolder (Part 1) course and those shown below safely and in their correct sequence.

Content:

- Assessment of skills and experience of Trainee Scaffolder (Part 1) jobs
- Instruction/Training SG4 (½ day)
- Product familiarisation in approved prefabricated systems scaffold
- Truss out scaffolds
- Scaffolds using prefabricated beams
- Protective fans and Pavement Gantry
- Loading bay (tube/fitting & system)
- Roof saddle/stack
- Splay scaffold
- Roof edge protection
- TG4 Tie Testing
- Alterations to scaffolds (eg: removing standards from a structure)
- NVQ level 2 registration and information
- 50 Question Test Paper (includes intermediate test at end of 1st week)
